We have a full summer schedule of short term classes, intensives and themed camps. Summer is an excellent time for students to develop technique and try new styles. Our summer schedule is short term and not on-going, sign up for what works best with your schedule. There are no registration or costume fees on our summer schedule.

Themed camps (beginning; 3-9 yrs):

Dance based on a theme with crafts and activities held 4 days consecutively, Monday-Thursday the same time every day. There will be a parent observation on the last day during the last 15 minutes of classes so parents can see what students worked on during the week.

Intensives (beginning-advanced; 2.5-18 yrs):

Intensives are 4 day consecutive classes, Monday-Thursday that are the same time every day and are done. There will be a parent observation on the last day during the last 15 minutes of classes so parents can see what students worked on during the week.

Classes (High Beginning-Advanced; 3rd-12th Grades):

One-time technique based classes. No observation is held for onetime classes.

We have three levels of ability and time commitment: Prep, Intensive, and Convention Companies.

Level 1: Prep Jazz Companies(Minimum hours 1.75 hours per week)

The Elite Prep Companies are designed for K-12th grade dancers seeking a higher level of commitment than our recreational classes, while not quite ready for our Intensive Companies & have a dedicated focus. Auditions are not required for Prep. Students are expected to have at least one year of dance and performing experience and must commit to a seasonal contract. Additionally, they should genuinely enjoy coming to dance, as fostering a love for the art is fundamental to our program.

Level 2: Intensive Jazz/Lyrical, Contemporary, Hip Hop Companies (Minimum hours 3-8 hours+ per week depending on age and ability)

The Elite Intensive Companies offer accelerated dance training for K-12th-grade students for Jazz/Lyrical and 2nd-12th students for Hip Hop & Contemporary seeking more training in these styles & have a dedicated focus. Intensive students are committed to attending intensive clinics and auditions, summer intensives, regular season classes covering ballet, jazz, jazz technique, lyrical, acro & contemporary and hip hop. They participate in scheduled extra practices, performances, and at least three competitions throughout the season, with second grade and up attending a fourth competition in Northern Utah. Auditions are held June 4-6 and are open to current and non-current students.



Level 3: Convention Companies (Jazz, Lyrical, Hip Hop, Contemporary)

(Minimum hours 9+ per week depending ability)

The Elite Convention Companies are for intermediate and advanced students in 5th-12th grades aspiring to dance at a pre-professional level and have a dedicated focus.

Convention students are committed to attending intensive clinics and auditions, summer intensives, regular season classes covering ballet, jazz, jazz technique, lyrical, acro, contemporary, hip hop & tap.

Throughout the season they participate in scheduled extra practices, take masterclasses, have guest choreographers, participate in local performances, attend three local competitions, one Northern Utah competition, and at least two conventions in Las Vegas. Auditions are held June 4-6 and are open to current and non-current students.


